Listed below is important information for the upcoming weekend:



**Programs:** Be sure to pick up a copy of the program when you arrive! Available at MAYLA HQ.

**Rules:** We will follow all regular season rules per NFHS and MAYLA rule exceptions and policies. There will be a copy of MAYLA rules in the field binders located at the scorer's table.

**Games:**

- Each team will play 2 games on Saturday and 2 games on Sunday.
- Games will start on the hour with a central horn.
- Two 23-minute halves, with a running clock (does not stop for goals, time-out, injury, etc.). 3-minute half-time.
- Timeouts: Each team is allowed one time out per half (with running clock). There will be no time outs allowed in the last two minutes of the game.
- All games will be officiated by certified referees.
- If weather conditions dictate, the festival committee reserves the right to shorten or cancel games, as necessary, without rebate of fees.
- Fields 1, 2, 5 & 6 will have bleachers available. It is recommended to bring your own chairs.
- Please clean up your area at the completion of each game (both sidelines!)

**Team Responsibilities:**

- Each team will need to bring one dozen balls for game balls. Bring additional balls on Sunday, if needed.
- **Each team will need to assign a culture keeper for each game**
- Designated home team (boldface and underlined on schedule) needs to provide 2 adult volunteers to manage the scoring table.
- ***VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED!*** Please encourage your families to volunteer during the break between games (parking, fastest shot contest, raffle runners, floaters, etc.). Please have all volunteers arranged prior to the weekend, using [SignUpGenius](#).

**Parking:** Please see the attached map to plan ahead for parking! Please park in designated parking spots only. There is no parking on the driveways alongside Fields 2 – 6. Please do not park on County Hwy K. or outside of the designated parking at the risk of towing. Handicap parking is available at North Campus near Doors #1, 9, and 15.

Consider bringing wagons if you have much to carry as not all parking will be adjacent to the playing field.



Best lot options by field number:

- Field #1: Lots A, B, C, E, or along tennis courts
- Field #2: Lots E, F or Mullet Ice Rink parking
- Field #3: Lot F
- Field #4 and #5: Lots D, F, G or H
- Field# 6 and #7: Lots D and H
- Field # 8: Lots A, C, D, E or along tennis courts

**Team Tents:** Please locate your team tents only in the locations indicated on the map. Overflow area will be in the greenspace off of Door 3.

**Water:** Will be provided at the fields. Bring your own water bottle.

**Rest rooms:** There are indoor restrooms accessed by Door #10 or Door #15 and just south of the football stadium. There are porta-potties and hand sanitizer located throughout the campus. See map for locations.

**Athletic trainer services:** Athletic trainers will be provided by ProHealth Care and are available in the case of injury or other emergencies. The trainers' tent will be located off Door #10. See map for location.

**HandBid Silent Auction:** See the instructions at the end of this guide for using Handbid. You can download anytime and review items beginning on **Wed., May 16 at noon**. Bidding will begin at **6am on May 17** and close at **noon on May 20**. This app is incredibly easy to use. Sign up for the notifications on bidding and you can rebid from the comfort of your seat on the sidelines! There are many fun and exciting items including many lacrosse items (equipment, camps, leagues, apparel), 2-day stay at Door County cottage, theme baskets, Brewer's tickets and more! Stop by the MAYLA headquarters tent to check out the offerings! Items must be picked up &/or paid for by 5:00 pm on Sunday.
