Take these steps to become a women's lacrosse official: (see www.uslacrosse.org and browse under "Officials")

1. Become an official member of US Lacrosse (\$50/adult/year; \$35/high school age/year)
2. Join your Local Umpiring Board (\$40/adult; \$10/hs age)
3. Complete US Lacrosse classroom & field training session
4. Pass the online Women's Rules Course
5. Pass the online Annual Rules Test
6. Pass an On Field Evaluation (referred to as "field rating")
7. Continue your growth as an official & climb up the ratings ladder by participating in more US Lacrosse training
